Silver Bay Public Library has two reading programs for 18 years old & under:

- ✚ Readers 6th grade (completed) & below will be eligible for prizes:
 - Display case prize awarded after 2 table activity creations.
 - Duck pond prize awarded after 2 hours reading recorded on reading log
- ✚ The Teen (young adult) program "MAKE WAVES @ THE LIBRARY" is for readers in 7 – 12th grade (completed). Teen readers are eligible for a weekly drawing "Chance" slips: Earn one slip for every 200 pages read OR 2 hours time spent reading. Drawings will be held Fridays for three winners to receive one FREE book of choice (\$5.99 value).

RULES:

Reader participants may sign up anytime during the summer program beginning Mon., June 7th

Read library books on both participant's reading level / age-appropriate books; books may be read to young children

Book logs are kept in the library, record time: Up to ½ hour/day may be written in the book log (**2 hours may be logged in every Monday & 3 hours on Tuesday, July 6th**)

Log in up to ½ hr. the first day AFTER sign-up. First prize received after first entry on reading record.

Participants may not record time in the log the same day as read/sign-up

ANY participant signing up after June 30th may sign in UP TO 5 hrs to get started on earning prizes.

Summer Reading Program Rules 2010

June 7 – July 30, 2010

Completed 6th Grade and younger

1. Tell what the theme is/date of program
2. Put name & number on sign-up log MATCH number to log number
3. Give participant name tag (optional for board) with book bag: bookmark, srp booklet & fish
4. First Prize (Duck pond) after 1st book - stamp with logo stamp
5. Tell about programs (activity sheet)
6. ½ hr. per day (except Mondays=2 hours / July 6 = 3 hours) **1 sticker= ½ hour reading
7. Display case prize after two (2) activity table creations. STAMP & date log when prizes given
8. Duck Pond prize after every 2 hours – pull duck from water, child chooses from receives that numbered prize bin

NOTE: ONLY Beg. Readers may log both time reading on their own and books read to - to give credit for their effort learning to reading.

Handout: bag, bookmark, reading log/time sheet, booklet, participant nametag to hang on bulletin board

Young Adult 7th – 12th grade completed

1. Put name on sign-up sheet – use YA for age
 2. tell what the theme is
 3. Give log - write name & number on (Optional participant name tag – seagulls or boats)
 4. Give 2 drawing slips for signing up and sweatshirt
 5. One prize (Give choice) after first entry in log: use Logo stamp
 6. Drawing slip given for every 200 pages or 2 hours/day time for Friday drawing use stamp
- Draw on Fridays: three names for free \$5.99 pbk. of choice Must use by 12/31/10.

- Photo must be an original taken by the entrant. Photos can be digital or non-digital taken with any type of camera.
- Photos can be printed on photo paper or regular paper. No size requirements.
- Photos can be submitted from Monday June 7th until 12:00 pm Friday, August 6th. Please drop off photos at the circulation desk or mail to the Silver Bay Public Library (see back for submission form)
- Library Staff will decide winning pictures by Tuesday, August 10th. Winning pictures will be displayed in the library display case during the month of August.
- Entry limit of 2 photos per person. Participants must be between the ages of 12 and 18 years of age.
- Prizes will be awarded to the creators of the top 3 submissions in each category:

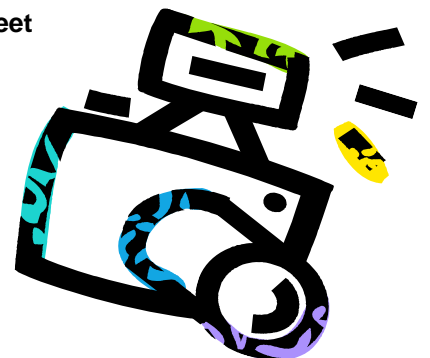
Two categories for photo entries:
